Think of the different types of animals and how they might be in one soul group or another. Take for example bears. There are griz-

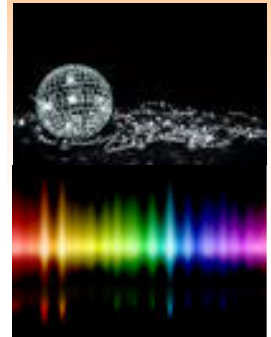
